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Pasote Tequila

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3 Badge Mixology, the spirits division of 3 Badge Beverage Corp. in California, has released Pasote, a line of Mexican tequilas — Blanco, Reposado and Añejo (all 40% ABV) — distilled from 100% Weber Blue Agave.



The name Pasote comes from “the fierce spirit of Aztec warriors and their uncompromising commitment,” according to a company statement. The labels feature hand-screened graphics of warriors.

Reposado was aged six months in American oak, and Añejo was aged for a year in American oak.

A 750-ml bottle of Blanco sells for about \$49, about \$59 for Reposado and about \$69 for Añejo.
